Lewis Pavilion during the week of the fair. **Exhibits and any associated paperwork (if not previously submitted) must be delivered on the Saturday prior to the opening of the fair between 12:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.** Exhibits must be picked up on the Sunday following the final day of the fair between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. *Please bring your exhibit tags at the time of pick-up.*

Rules and Regulations:

1. Only one entry per class will be accepted from each exhibitor.
2. Open to All Crafters at Any Skill Level.
3. All Articles must have been made by the person entering the article.
4. The Superintendent has the right to reclassify any item if the judge so desires.
5. Any Article for hanging on walls must be equipped with a suitable and sturdy hanger. No glass in Frames.
