## **ENTER THE FAIRY GARDEN CONTEST!**

Qualifying exhibits will be displayed in the Wiser Horticulture Pavilion during the week of the fair. **Entry forms may be submitted to the Fair Office in advance to expedite check-in; however, advance submission is not required. Exhibits and any associated paperwork (if not previously submitted) must be delivered on the Tuesday prior to the opening of the fair between 12:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.** Exhibits must be picked up on the Sunday following the final day of the fair between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. *Please bring your exhibit tags at the time of pick-up.*

### **Rules and Regulations:**

1. Entries will be accepted and released according to the Open Class Horticulture/Floriculture schedule.
2. The contest is open to participants of all ages. Entries will be judged in separate Adult and Youth divisions, with awards presented in each category.
3. Each Fairy Garden must contain living plants. The garden must be displayed in a single container not to exceed 25 pounds. An optional display stand may be used; however, the stand may not exceed 4 feet square in size or 25 pounds in weight.
4. Fairy Gardens must be accompanied by a description or story suitable for display. The display must be submitted on an 8½" x 11" sheet of paper and displayed with the Fairy Garden.
5. Judging will be based on creativity, use of materials, and description/story.
6. All Fairy Gardens must be removed by 1:00 p.m. on the Sunday following the close of the fair. Exhibitors who are unable to retrieve their entry must make arrangements with the superintendent before or during entry time.
7. Exhibitors must indicate the appropriate division on the entry form: Adult or Youth (ages 4–15).
