Equine Activity Release



All riders must complete and deposit with the Yamhill County Fairgrounds, either in the office or the designated drop box, a fully completed and signed waiver PRIOR to unloading and riding or otherwise working with any horse or other type of equine on the fairgrounds. Should a new horse, not listed on this waiver be brought to the fairgrounds, a new waiver with the Horse name must be completed.

The Yamhill County Fairgrounds attempts to maintain Delashmutt and Drader arena in a condition sufficient to support general horse riding. Pursuant to ORS 30.693 by completing and signing this Equine Activity Release equine riders and owners waive the right to bring an action against an equine professional, equine activity sponsor, the Yamhill County Fair Board, any employee of the Yamhill County Fair & Event Center, and Yamhill County or its agents for any injury or death arising out of use of a fairgrounds arena for equine related activities. These activities include, but are not limited to riding as a passenger upon the equine, training, driving, riding in an apparatus pulled by an equine, and grooming.

All equine participants using an arena during an Open Ride period, further agree that they will either have a current annual ride pass or will deposit a payment of \$10 per horse in the office or drop box each day they use an arena.
